

# RM12.7bil in unclaimed funds remain uncollected - Anwar

KUALA LUMPUR: As of Jan 31, a total of RM12.7 billion in unclaimed money remains uncollected, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has revealed.

In a written parliamentary reply to Kesavan Subramaniam (PH-Sungai Siput), Anwar, who also serves as finance minister, said individuals and rightful heirs can claim these funds through the National Accountant Department's eGUMIS portal or by visiting the state offices.

To raise awareness, the government has introduced multiple initiatives, including awareness campaigns, online briefings, announcements on television and as well as expanding customer service counters to 26 locations nationwide, Anwar said.

"The department has organised 158 awareness booths and programmes nationwide to help the public check for unclaimed money," Anwar said.
